Our story of the week was 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar.



We also shared 'The Crunching Munching Caterpillar'.



On Monday, it was lovely to welcome everyone back to pre-school. The children were all keen to talk about their various holiday activities and to see one another. They were all very lively!

During maths time, we have explored the composition of numbers 3 and 4. The children used mathematical language to explain the arrangement e.g. 2 in the pond and 1 on the log. Altogether 3. This week, the children have been taking part in some caterpillar themed activities. We shared the story of 'The Very Hungry Caterpillar' and then printed a caterpillar with a repeating pattern. The children found out about caterpillars and how they change. They also enjoyed threading some caterpillar beading strings.

On Friday, Gemma joined us for Rhythm Time and the children found out about crescendo (getting louder) and diminuendo (getting quieter). We also loved seeing Ratatat and helping him to read some musical sentences.
