Pre-school Weekly Newsletter Term: Summer two Week: three

Our story of the week was 'What the Ladybird Heard' by Julia Donaldson.



We also shared the story of 'The Very Lazy Ladybird'.



This week, we continued our minibeast theme learning about ladybirds. Our story of the week was another Julia Donaldson favourite, 'What the Ladybird Heard'. The children were fascinated to find real ladybirds and ladybird larvae out on our bug hunt. There were lots to find over by the year 1 and 2 classrooms.

On Monday, Mrs Cadman came to visit from Kidsgrove vets. She is a friend of Excalibur and delivered a free animal workshop. The children were invited to touch some of the animals if they wanted to but some preferred just to watch. We met a very old and slightly deaf dog named Fern. All she wanted was a constant tummy tickle. We also met two tiny tortoises, a small corn snake, a loppy-eared rabbit, some tropical frogs and a guinea pig. Mrs Cadman also left some colouring sheets for the children to decorate for the waiting room at Kidsgrove vets.

In maths, we have explored counting back one. The children used a number track to five to jump back just one space to the number before. Our rhyme of the week was 'Five Little Monkeys Jumping on the Bed'. Everyone enjoyed joining in with this one (especially the jumping up and down parts).
