



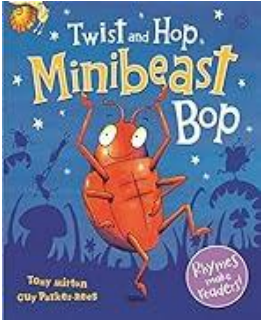

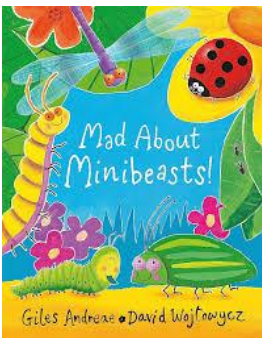
### Pre-school Weekly Newsletter
