As part of their topic this term, the children will be going on a walk around Alsager. The walk will allow the children to see the location of HMS Excalibur, the Royal Naval training base from which our school got its name, as well as exploring the local area in detail. It will also give the children a chance to compare what Alsager was like in the past.

The walk will take place on Friday 9th October and we will leave school promptly at 9:15am and we will arrive back at school at approximately 12:00pm so the children will be able to have lunch at school as normal. The afternoon will be spent collating what they learnt on their walk ready for their write-up for their topic books the following week.

As the walk will be over playtime, we have decided to have our snack as normal during the walk so please provide children with a healthy snack to bring with them. We will also take the children's water bottles on the walk, so please ensure your child has their full water bottle with them. These will need to be carried by the children so please provide a bag in which they can put their snack and water in, that can be easily carried by them. Children may wear their own clothes on the trip, but will need to wear their school jumper. As this trip is outdoors, suitable clothing and footwear will need to be worn as the children will be doing a fair bit of walking. Due to the unpredictability of the Great British weather it is asked that your child brings a waterproof coat. If the weather on the day is extremely poor, it may be decided to have the walk on another day.

As this walk makes use of our local area, there is no cost for the trip.
