We have now completed the recruitment process for Mrs Rogers' maternity leave. I am pleased to tell you that Mrs Heather Cheadle will be joining the team in February. Mrs Cheadle is an experienced specialist in Early Years and has a wealth of knowledge and experience that she will bring to our school. To ensure a smooth transition for everyone, we have managed to arrange for Mrs Cheadle to work alongside Mrs Rogers for approximately 2 weeks before she takes over the reception class when Mrs Rogers takes her leave. I am sure that you will join me in welcoming Mrs Cheadle to our school.

### **Christmas Fair**

It is Friends of Excalibur's Christmas Fair this Friday. The fun starts from **5pm** and ends at **7pm**. As always we hope that you are able to join the school and support the F.O.E – I know the children always look forward to this event. If you can spare half an hour to help out on a stall, set up or help clear away at the end then please send in your slip or let the office know. Thank you in anticipation of your support.

In January there will be a census to identify the number of children in school who are eligible for Pupil Premium Funding. This determines the school's income for Pupil Premium from April 2016 to March 2017. This funding is allocated against a number of criteria, one of which is eligibility for Income Related Free School Meals. This is not the same as Universal Free School Meals which are currently available for all children in Reception and Key Stage One. Pupil Premium funding can be used by the school in a variety of ways to support and enrich children's education. This can include free school trips, additional support through nurture, help with buying school uniform, or any other educational or additional support that the children need.

An initiative called Ever 6 means that children who are eligible for Income Related Free School Meals continue to receive Pupil Premium funding for six years from the initial entitlement even if the parents' financial situation changes and they would no longer be eligible. This means that the children can continue to benefit from the additional funding throughout their primary education and possibly into high school. Please see Mrs Hilditch in the office or visit
