At parent/carer teacher consultations, we will be once more distributing our annual parent/carer questionnaire. It is very useful for us to have feedback and this is always reflected upon at a strategic level with governors. Please do complete the survey – it helps us to know what is working well and what we can/should develop further. A few examples of the ideas from the last couple of years are:

You said – the drive is dark when leaving events at the night.

We did – made budgetary provision to enable us to put lighting and electricity down the drive – work to be completed in 2016.

You said – music provision seems excellent. We did – ensured our commitment to special projects continued into 2015-16, extending this to include Early Years.

You said – dinner staff should communicate more with teachers.

We did – establish half termly meetings with the senior leadership team and midday assistants to discuss any specific issues or developments from lunchtimes. You said – a mid-year written report? We did – now that we are embedding assessment without levels into our school, we are offering an information evening for all parents. From next academic year will be introducing a pupil mid-year report card.

You said – more after school clubs for Y2 We did – Y2 have been able to access football, homework, multisports and coding clubs so far this year.

Of course, as you can see from the parent views section of our website, you also gave us much positive feedback about what we do well, what works for your child and what we should keep doing. So, your feedback is very much valued and we do hope that you can complete the survey again for 2016.
