We are getting really good at counting forwards and backwards to 20 and experts at subitising to 5. This week we were challenged to subitise what we could see on a 10's frame. We also used our 10's frames to help us as we combined groups to find totals. Some of us were able to write the number sentence to show this. As well as counting in 1's we explored making pairs which led some of us to count in 2's. We finished our number work this week by moving along a number line.

In our last week before half term we will find out about the upcoming Shrove Tuesday, Valentine's Day and Chinese New Year.
